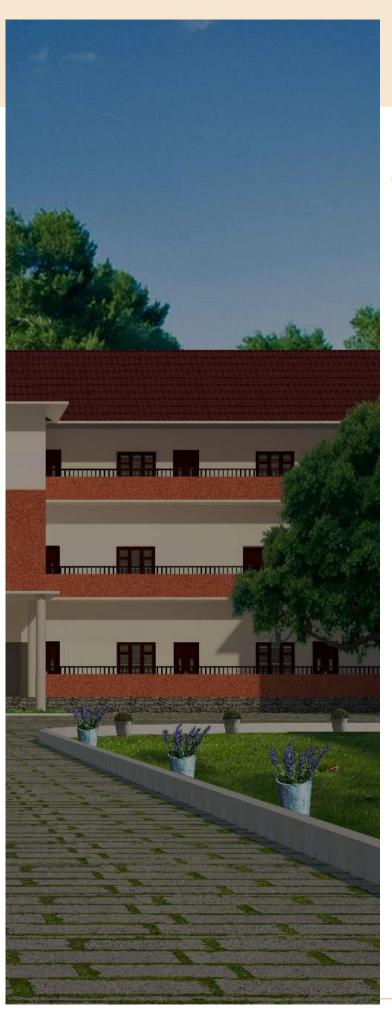


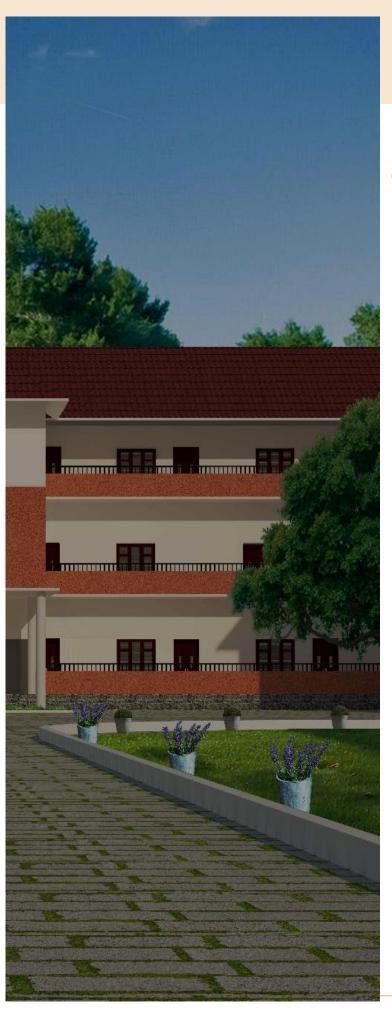
INTRODUCTION

- It is the first minority institution in Kerala and aided Arabic College affiliated to University of Calicut, approved by University Grants Commission, New Delhi in 2010.
- It was originally affiliated to the University of Madras in 1944.
 Following the formation of the united Kerala in 1956, the University of Kerala granted permanent affiliation to the College and has been under the University of Calicut since 1973.
- It functioned as a single faculty / discipline college for more than 60 years.
- The Government of Kerala sanctioned two degree courses i.e.
 M.A Islamic Finance and B.A. Functional Arabic to the College in the year of 2015.
- The PG Department of the College has been upgraded by the University as Research Centre in Arabic in the year 2020.
- The College is offering Afzal Ulama Preliminary (a two year pre-university course), B.A. Afzalul Ulama Degree in Arabic, B.A Functional Arabic, M.A. Afzalul Ulama in Arabic, PhD in Arabic and M.A Islamic Finance



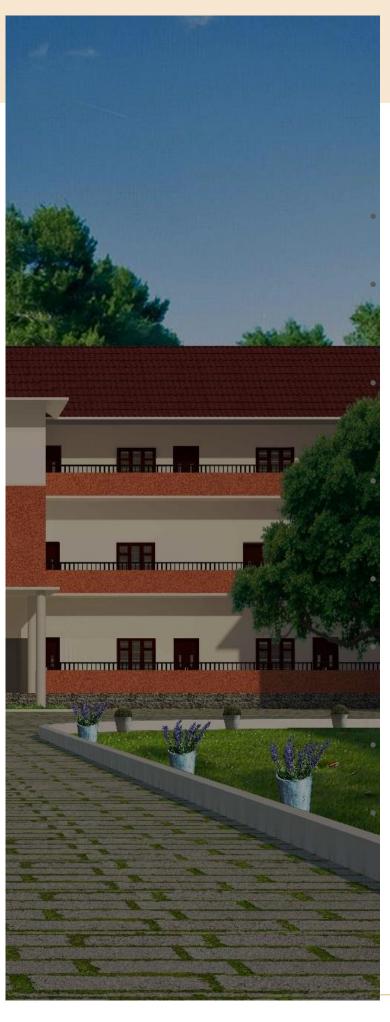
VISION

Help the students to develop unwavering confidence and faith in virtuous thought.

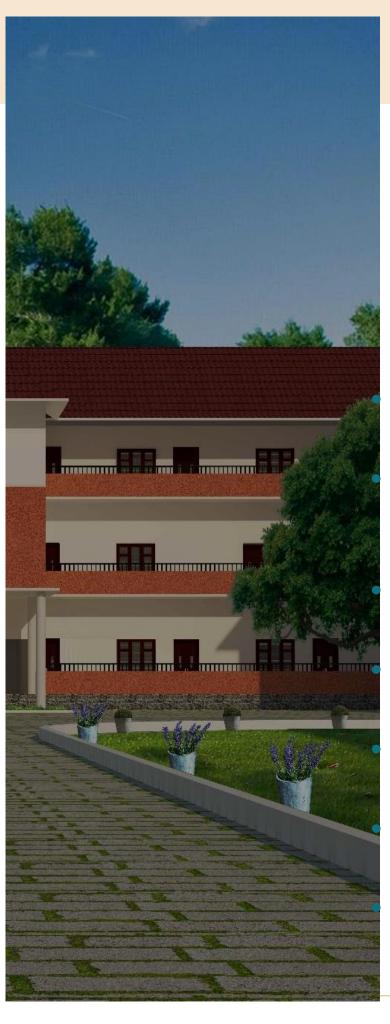
Help the student community in developing a humane outlook and strong civic sense.

Research forum to inculcate research culture among the students and faculty members.

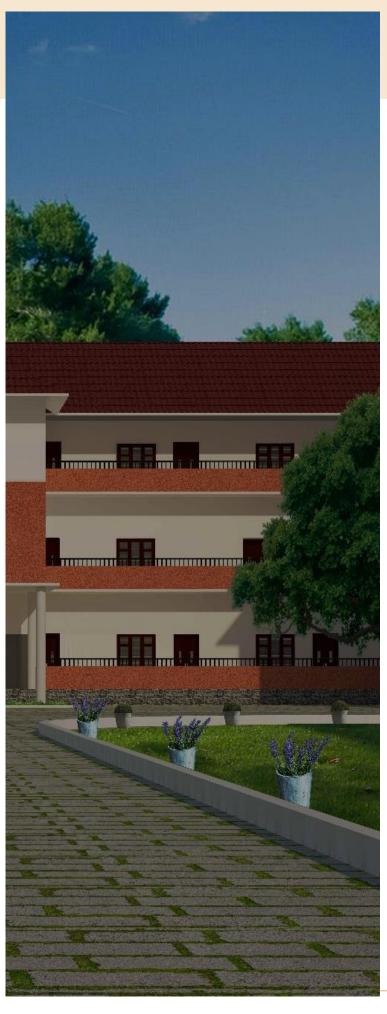
More minor and major research projects by the faculty members.

Convert aided PG department to research departments.

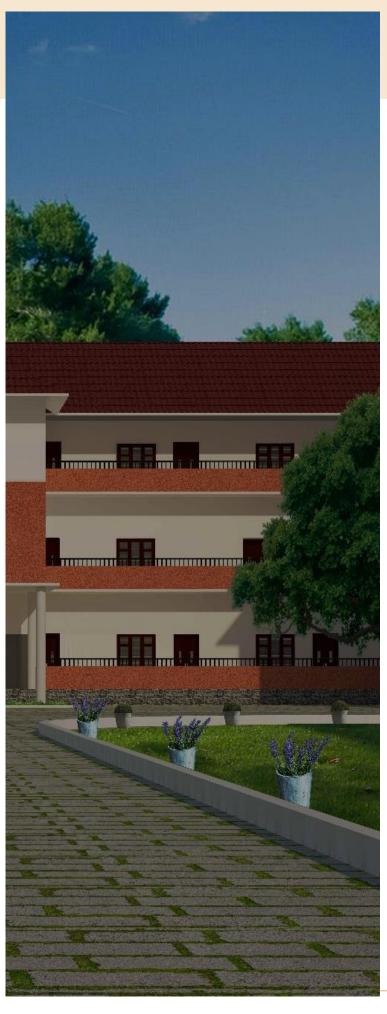
Research guides in PG departments.

Liberal leave policy for faculty members who pursue PhD in FDP.



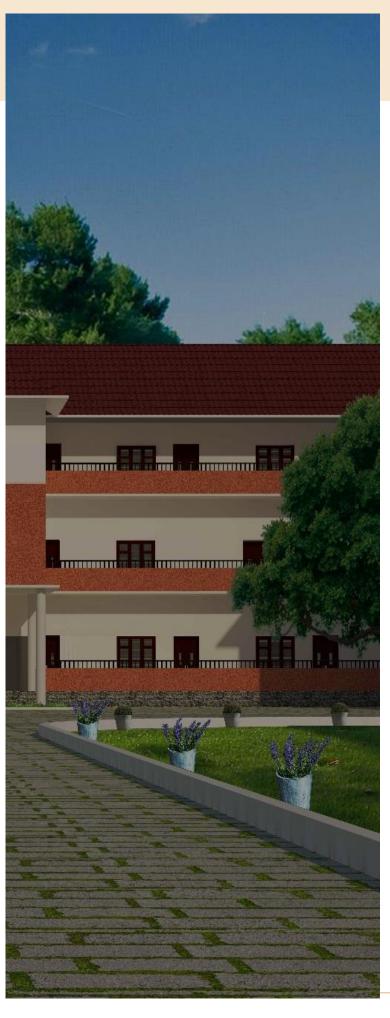
ACADEMICS WITH EMPHASIS ON SKILL BASED EDUTION

- Deliver the needed support and guidance for students in developing and improving their skills and aptitudes.



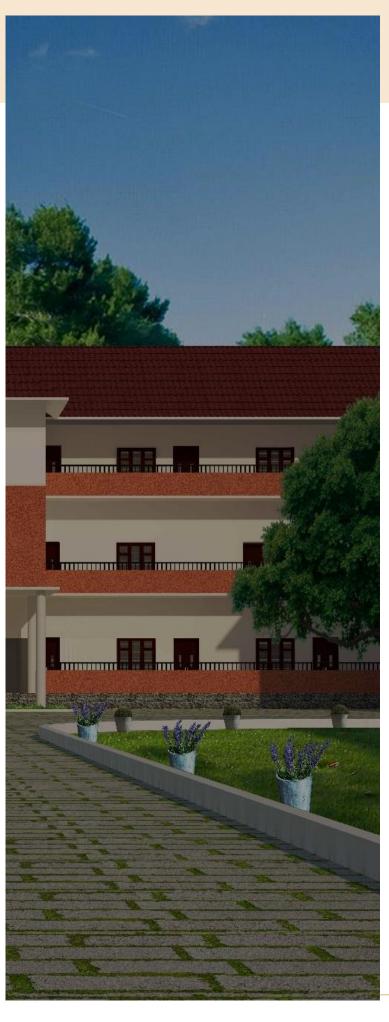
INNOVATION & ENTERPENEURSHIP PLAN

- More Industry-academic linkage by introducing innovative programs.



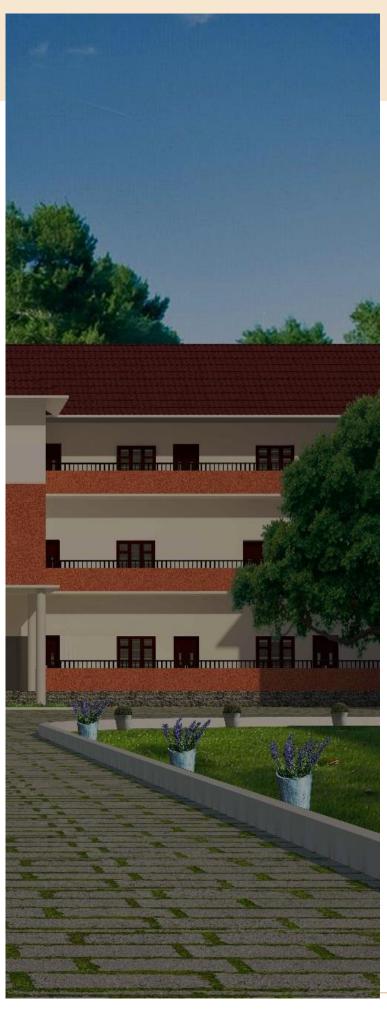
INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN

STUDENT SUPPORT

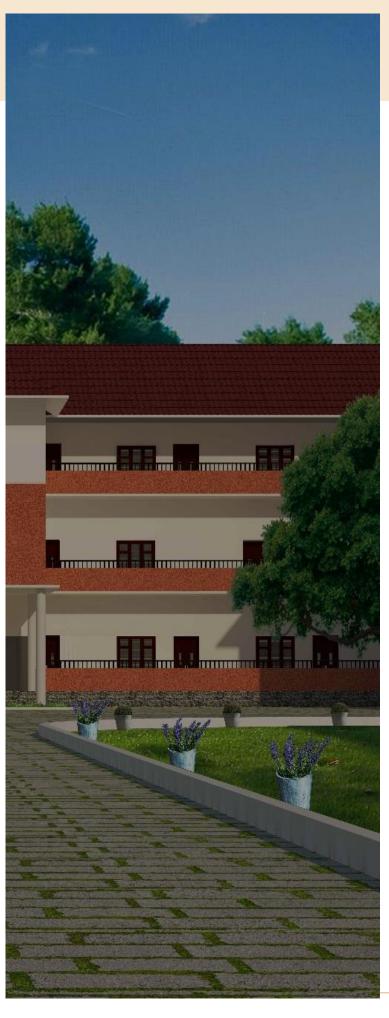
- More classrooms with ICT facilities

GREEN INITIATIVE

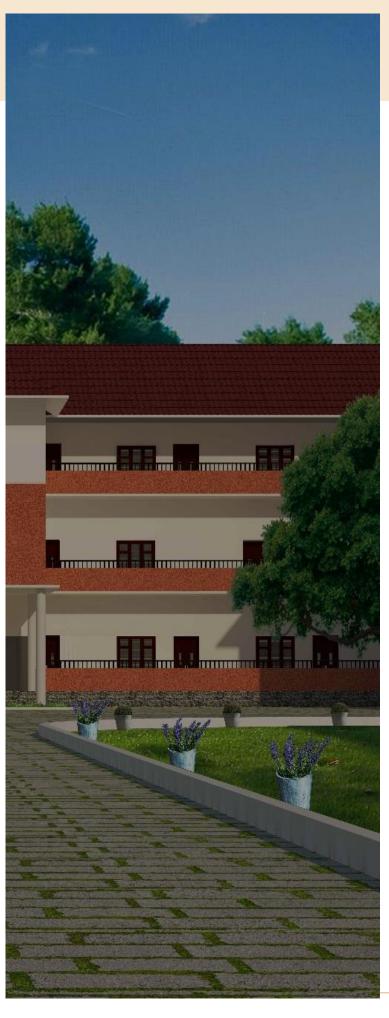
