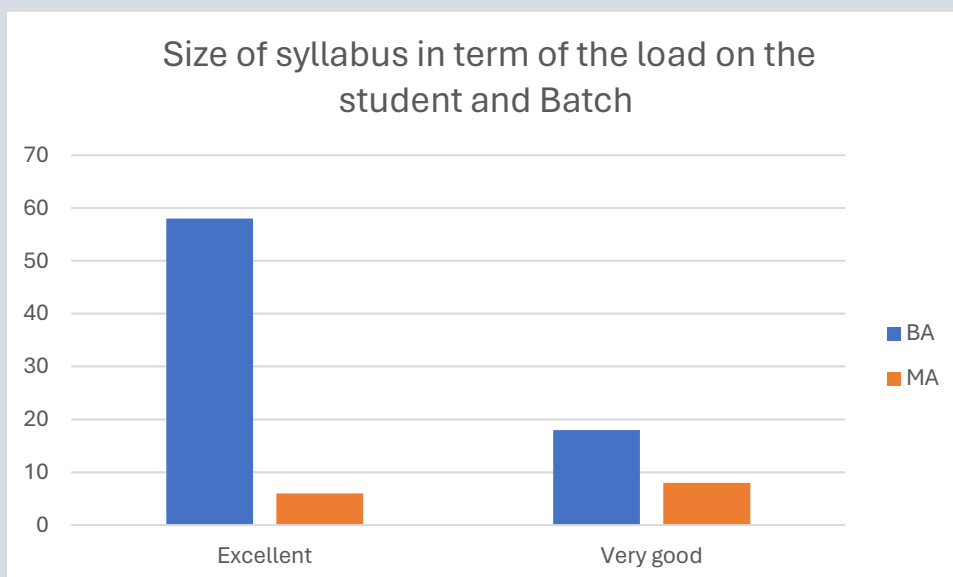


Support for Higher Education: An overwhelming 95% of students express satisfaction with the support they receive for higher education from the college. This high level of support is crucial in

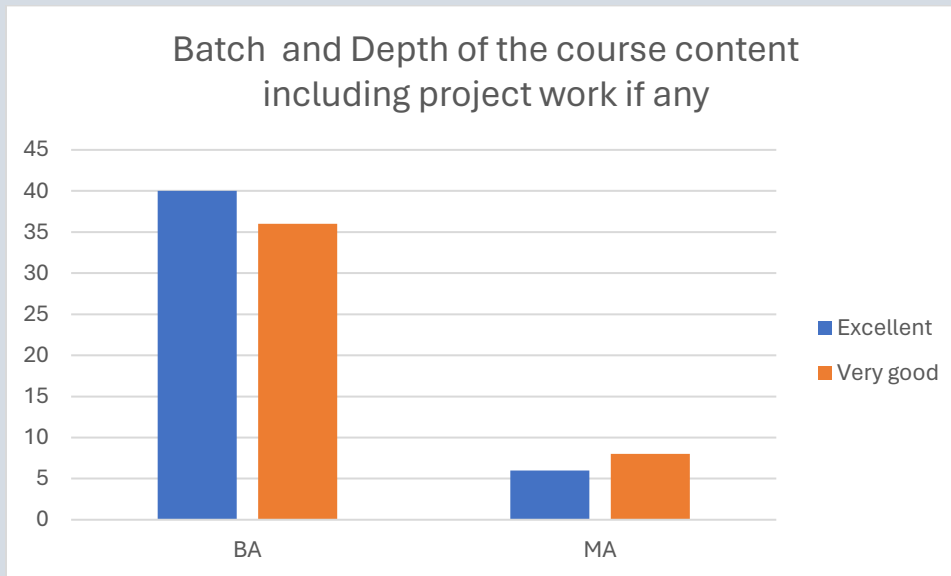

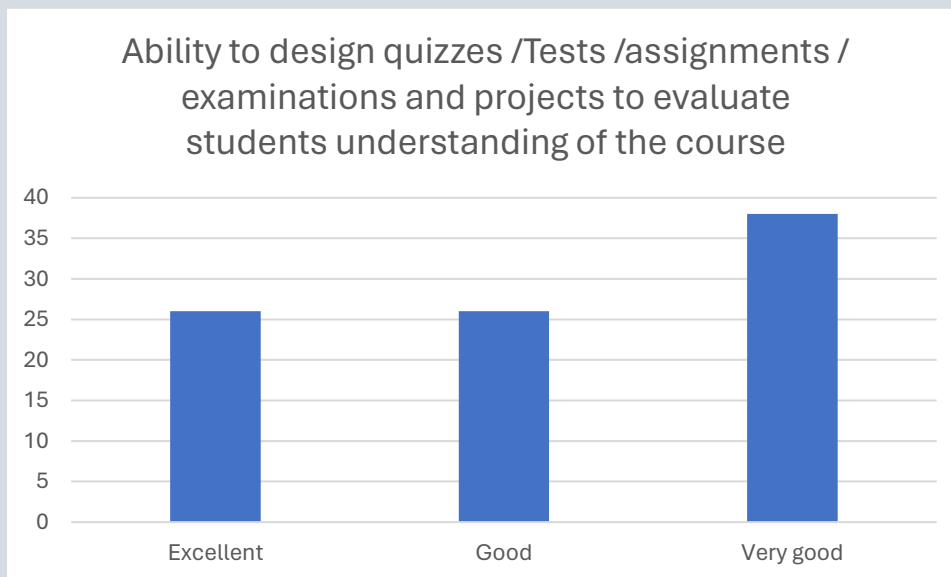
Recommendations
