KC, Mrs. Rasnim (PRO of Iqraa Maternity Hospital), Mrs. Shaharban, and Jaseera felicitated the function.



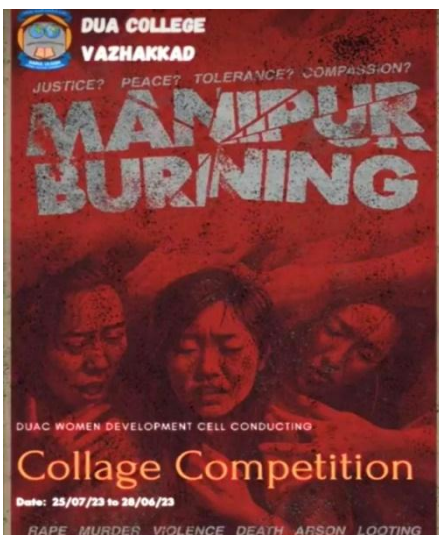
INTRICATE PATTERNS
