

The feedback for the academic year 2023-24 was gathered from teachers, students, alumni, and employers focusing on critical parameters such as curriculum relevance, teaching effectiveness, resource availability, and overall experience.


The responses were meticulously analyzed, and this report provides a detailed summary of the feedback received along with key findings and recommendations. Overall, the feedback reflects positively on the college's efforts to maintain academic excellence.

1. Feedback from Teachers

Key Findings:

- 1. **Overall Experience:** A significant majority of teachers rated their overall experience with the college as excellent or very good, with an average rating of 3.52 out of 5.
- 2. **Syllabus Load:** While most teachers found the syllabus load manageable, a few suggested redistributing certain topics to balance the workload better.
- 3. Clarity and Relevance of Reading Material: The reading materials provided were rated highly, with an average score of 3.57 out of 5.
- 4. **Syllabus Content and Quality:** Teachers expressed satisfaction with the syllabus content, with the majority describing it as "Average" or "Easy" to follow.
- 5. **E-resources and Practical Relevance:** A considerable percentage of teachers appreciated the availability of syllabus-based e-resources and their connection to real-life applications.





Suggestions:

- Introduce professional training modules and specialized courses to enhance the curriculum.
- Increase the use of digital tools for better teaching outcomes.


Actions Taken:

2. Feedback from Students

Key Findings:

- 1. **Syllabus Load and Applicability:** Students rated the syllabus load as acceptable and applicable to real-life situations, with an average rating of 3.43 and 3.38 respectively.
- 2. **Resource Availability:** Library resources and reference materials were highly appreciated, with students rating this aspect at 3.75 on average.
- 3. Clarity of Reading Material: The clarity and relevance of textual materials were rated highly, averaging 3.69 out of 5.
- 4. **Support for Higher Education:** The extent of support provided by the institution for higher education was rated as very good, with an average score of 4.



5. **Depth and Practicality of Content:** Students acknowledged the depth of course content and the inclusion of real-world applications, with average ratings of 3.62 and 3.63 respectively.

Suggestions:

- Include more interactive sessions and workshops to enhance practical understanding.
- Provide additional opportunities for internships and real-world projects.


Actions Taken:

- 4. **Suggestions for Improvement:** Alumni suggested a deeper focus on advanced topics and more practical exposure to prepare students for industry challenges.



Suggestions:

- Introduce advanced electives in emerging fields.
- Strengthen alumni engagement programs for mentorship and networking opportunities.

Actions Taken:

- Advanced electives have been proposed for the upcoming academic year.
- Alumni mentoring sessions have been initiated to bridge the gap between academics and industry expectations.

4. Feedback from Employers

Feedback Received:
